APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1] Complete the on-line application form at: www.sjr.mb.ca/admissions. Please note that a valid credit card is required to complete the on-line application process.
- 2] Scan and email a copy of the student's final report card from the previous year along with two most recent academic reports as well as a recent photo of the student to: admissions@sjr.mb.ca
- 3] Grade 1 - 12 applicants are required to include a completed teacher evaluation form.

Upon receipt of the application materials, the family will be notified about admissions testing and other requirements.

SELECTION PROCESS

The admissions committee makes its selection for enrolment based upon the availability of space in the grade and in the residential facility. The committee focuses on the student's potential for academic success and the likelihood of his/her contribution to the School's co-curricular life.

ENROLMENT PROCEDURES AND CONDITIONS

Once a student is accepted by the School, the family will receive instructions on how to sign into our On-line Enrolment System to complete the on-line enrolment contract. There is an initial admission fee of \$2,250. Both the contract and admissions fee must be completed within two weeks of the date of acceptance. Students are enrolled for the entire academic year.

** International students must submit payment in full immediately following acceptance to allow sufficient time for processing of visa/study permit application.

Approval for the use of the Installment Plan will only be granted after successfully completing any credit checks which the administration deems appropriate. This option includes an interest rate of 17.5% per annum on the declining balance.

The tuition fee includes:

- Daily bus transportation (within city limits; door to door service is not guaranteed)
- Lunches
- Junior School classroom supplies
- Middle School basic supplies
- Cost of travel, accommodation and group meals associated with the 3-day fall camp/trip for students in Grades 4 - 8
- Basic costs associated with our co-curricular and special classroom programs
- Boarding tuition includes room and board

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

The tuition fee does not include:

- \$2,250 one-time initial admission fee to be paid once a student has been accepted to the School.
- Additional boarding costs (i.e. long distance charges, taxis, drug store purchases, etc.) including charges relating to building repair, maintenance and housekeeping incurred as a direct result of student misconduct or neglect
- Additional costs relating to services and/or equipment outlined in an SJR Adapted Education Plan, should one be required, as per an SJR Student Services Supplemental Support Agreement which would be appended to the contract as required.
- Classroom supplies for Senior School students
- Some individualized Middle School supplies
- Personal electronic device meeting the specifications of the School's 1-to-1 technology program
- School uniforms, team uniforms & required physical education equipment (available at the SJR uniform shop)
- Hockey registration fee for co-curricular hockey teams (team specific)
- Optional courses and activities such as drivers' education, self-defence courses, etc.
- Optional activities on Junior or Middle School Activity days
- Private music lessons
- Soccer registration fee for co-curricular soccer teams (team specific)
- Special optional trips by athletic teams, debating teams, or other groups, including ski trips and outdoor education activities
- Tournament, band and choir trips: travel, food, and accommodations
- Weekly and extra allowances distributed to boarding students
- Yearbook
